

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force survey data, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages.

- The number of employed persons in Mackay - Isaac - Whitsunday SA4 in September 2023 was 106,200 persons, a decrease of 2,100 employed persons, or 1.9% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, September 2023

- The unemployment rate in Mackay - Isaac - Whitsunday SA4 in September 2023 was 3.5 per cent, an increase of 1.0 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the tenth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Mackay - Isaac - Whitsunday SA4 in September 2023 was 70.6 per cent, a decrease of 3.2 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Mackay - Isaac - Whitsunday SA4
