



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Ipswich SA4 in April 2024 was 198,400 persons, an increase of 13,100 employed persons, or 7.1% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, April 2024

- The unemployment rate in Ipswich SA4 in April 2024 was 4.8 per cent, a decrease of 1.6 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the thirdhighest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Ipswich SA4 in April 2024 was 66.4 per cent, an increase of 0.7 percentage point over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Ipswich SA4
