

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Cairns SA4 in May 2024 was 142,900 persons, an increase of 1,400 employed persons, or 1.0% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Cairns SA4 in May 2024 was 3.4 per cent, a decrease of 0.4 percentage point over the year.




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, May 2024

 The unemployment rate for this area was the fourth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Cairns SA4 in May 2024 was 67.2 per cent, a decrease of 1.4 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Cairns SA4
