

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Central Queensland SA4 in May 2024 was 124,900 persons, a decrease of 2,400 employed persons, or 1.9% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, May 2024

- The unemployment rate in Central Queensland SA4 in May 2024 was 4.5 per cent, an increase of 0.8 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the sixth-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Central Queensland SA4 in May 2024 was 68.2 per cent, a decrease of 2.5 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Central Queensland SA4
