



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Queensland Outback SA4 in May 2024 was 41,500 persons, an increase of 600 employed persons, or 1.4% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, May 2024

- The unemployment rate in Queensland Outback SA4 in May 2024 was 4.5 per cent, an increase of 0.3 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fifth-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Queensland Outback SA4 in May 2024 was 67.3 per cent, an increase of 0.3 percentage point over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Queensland - Outback SA4
