



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Wide Bay SA4 in May 2024 was 140,100 persons, an increase of 9,100 employed persons, or 7.0% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, May 2024

- The unemployment rate in Wide Bay SA4 in May 2024 was 4.7 per cent, a decrease of 0.3 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fourthhighest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Wide Bay SA4 in May 2024 was 52.8 per cent, an increase of 1.7 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Wide Bay SA4
