



Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Sunshine Coast SA4 in June 2024 was 227,300 persons, an increase of 19,200 employed persons, or 9.2% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, June 2024

- The unemployment rate in Sunshine Coast SA4 in June 2024 was 3.7 per cent, an increase of 0.9 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the seventh-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Sunshine Coast SA4 in June 2024 was 65.8 per cent, an increase of 4.2 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Sunshine Coast
