

## **Main findings**

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Townsville SA4 in June 2024 was 127,600 persons, a decrease of 5,100 employed persons, or 3.8% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, June 2024

- The unemployment rate in Townsville SA4 in June 2024 was 4.0 per cent, an increase of 1.7 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the tenth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Townsville SA4 in June 2024 was 67.5 per cent, a decrease of 3.3 percentage points over the year (Table 1).


