


Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Moreton Bay -North SA4





Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, August 2024

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Moreton Bay North SA4 in August 2024 was 126,300 persons, an increase of 8,900 employed persons, or 7.5% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Moreton Bay North SA4 in August 2024 was 6.4 per cent, an increase of 1.1 percentage points over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Moreton Bay North SA4 in August 2024 was 56.4 per cent, an increase of 2.9 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
