




### Employment growth, annual

## **Main findings**

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Toowoomba SA4 in August 2024 was 84,800 persons, an increase of 8,000 employed persons, or 10.4% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Toowoomba SA4 in August 2024 was 4.0 per cent, a decrease of 0.6 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the tenth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Toowoomba SA4 in August 2024 was 63.3 per cent, an increase of 4.1 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
