





Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane East SA4 in September 2024 was 137,600 persons, an increase of 1,200 employed persons, or 0.9% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, September 2024

- The unemployment rate in Brisbane East SA4 in September 2024 was 3.0 per cent, a decrease of 0.4 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the third-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane East SA4 in September 2024 was 68.2 per cent, a decrease of 1.1 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Brisbane - East
