Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Brisbane Inner City SA4





Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, September 2024

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in September 2024 was 219,500 persons, an increase of 10,500 employed persons, or 5.0% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in September 2024 was 3.9 per cent, an increase of 0.4 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the tenth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane Inner City SA4 in September 2024 was 78.8 per cent, an increase of 0.3 percentage point over the year (Table 1).
