Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Ipswich SA4





Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, September 2024

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Ipswich SA4 in September 2024 was 194,900 persons, an increase of 4,900 employed persons, or 2.6% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Ipswich SA4 in September 2024 was 5.5 per cent, an increase of 0.6 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the fourth-highest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Ipswich SA4 in September 2024 was 65.2 per cent, a decrease of 0.2 percentage point over the year (Table 1).
