





Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Mackay Isaac -Whitsunday SA4 in September 2024 was 103,500 persons, an increase of 200 employed persons, or 0.2% over the year (Figure 1).




Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, September 2024

- The unemployment rate in Mackay Isaac Whitsunday SA4 in September 2024 was 2.8 per cent, a decrease of 0.7 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the second-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Mackay Isaac Whitsunday SA4 in September 2024 was 68.5 per cent, a decrease of 1.8 percentage points over the year (Table 1).

Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Mackay - Isaac - Whitsunday SA4
