






## Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Brisbane - West

### Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Brisbane West SA4 in October 2024 was 112,800 persons, an increase of 2,100 employed persons, or 1.9% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Brisbane West SA4 in October 2024 was 3.5 per cent, an increase of 0.3 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the sixth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Brisbane West SA4 in October 2024 was 70.8 per cent, a decrease of 0.7 percentage point over the year (Table 1).
