


Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Darling Downs -Maranoa SA4





Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, October 2024

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Darling Downs -Maranoa SA4 in October 2024 was 66,100 persons, an increase of 2,400 employed persons, or 3.8% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Darling Downs Maranoa SA4 in October 2024 was 2.0 per cent, a decrease of 0.8 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Darling Downs Maranoa SA4 in October 2024 was 62.5 per cent, an increase of 1.0 percentage point over the year (Table 1).
