


Figure 1 Annual change in employment, Sunshine Coast SA4





Figure 2 Unemployment rate by SA4, October 2024

Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data.

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- The number of employed persons in Sunshine Coast SA4 in October 2024 was 226,200 persons, an increase of 9,500 employed persons, or 4.4% over the year (Figure 1).
- The unemployment rate in Sunshine Coast SA4 in October 2024 was 3.6 per cent, an increase of 0.5 percentage point over the year. The unemployment rate for this area was the eighth-lowest of all 19 SA4s within Queensland (Figure 2).
- The participation rate in Sunshine Coast SA4 in October 2024 was 65.0 per cent, an increase of 1.3 percentage points over the year (Table 1).
