Main findings

Note: Due to the high standard errors associated with regional labour force direct survey estimates, the ABS and QGSO recommend using 12-month averages to reduce the volatility of the underlying original data

All data in this brief are based on 12-month moving averages of direct survey estimates.

- Darling Downs Maranoa SA4 had the lowest youth unemployment rate of all 19 SA4s during June 2024 with an unemployment rate of 4.1 per cent (Figure 1).
- Moreton Bay North SA4 had the highest youth unemployment rate of all 19 SA4s during June 2024 with an unemployment rate of 14.9 per cent (Figure 1).





Figure 2 Annual change in youth unemployment rate by SA4, June 2024

- Wide Bay SA4 had the largest percentage point decrease in the youth unemployment rate of all 19 SA4s over the year to June 2024 with an unemployment rate decrease of 4.1 percentage points (Figure 2).
- Moreton Bay North SA4 had the largest percentage point increase in the youth unemployment rate of all 19 SA4s over the year to June 2024 with an unemployment rate increase of 5.4 percentage points (Figure 2).

Figure 1 Youth unemployment rate by SA4, June 2024
