

Main findings

Note: Commentary on monthly figures is based on nominal values throughout and, as such, movements are affected by price and quantity changes.

Due to the impacts of COVID-19 the ABS has suspended the trend series from March 2020 to June 2022 (inclusive). At present, all results in this brief are presented in seasonally adjusted terms.

- The seasonally adjusted estimate of Queensland's retail turnover decreased 0.2% in April 2024.
 Australia's seasonally adjusted retail turnover increased 0.1% in April 2024.
- The seasonally adjusted value of Queensland's nominal retail turnover decreased from \$7,353.0 million in March 2024 to \$7,341.7 million in April 2024.




Figure 2 Annual change in retail turnover, April 2024

- The seasonally adjusted value of Queensland's retail turnover increased by 2.2% over the previous 12 months, from \$7,182.2 million in April 2023 (Figure 2).
- Queensland recorded the third-highest annual growth in retail turnover of all states and territories (2.2%).
 Northern Territory recorded the highest increase (3.6%).

Figure 1 Monthly change in retail turnover
