Main findings

Note: Commentary on monthly figures is based on nominal values throughout and, as such, movements are affected by price and quantity changes.

Due to the impacts of COVID-19 the ABS has suspended the trend series from February 2020. All results are therefore presented in seasonally adjusted terms.

- The seasonally adjusted estimate of Queensland's retail turnover increased 0.8% in August 2024.
 Australia's seasonally adjusted retail turnover increased 0.7% in August 2024.
- The seasonally adjusted value of Queensland's nominal retail turnover increased from \$7,465.9 million in July 2024 to \$7,525.5 million in August 2024.
- The increase in Queensland's nominal retail turnover in August 2024 reflected higher spending in Department stores and Cafes, restaurants and takeaway food services.




Figure 2 Annual change in retail turnover, August 2024

- The seasonally adjusted value of Queensland's retail turnover increased by 4.2% over the previous 12 months, from \$7,225.3 million in August 2023 (Figure 2).
- Queensland recorded the third-highest annual growth in retail turnover of all states and territories (4.2%).
 Northern Territory recorded the highest increase (5.9%).




Figure 3 Monthly retail turnover contribution to growth by industry group, August 2024

- Department stores recorded the largest contribution to retail turnover growth in Queensland in the month (0.30 percentage point). Food retailing recorded the largest contribution to retail turnover growth in Australia (0.23 percentage point) in August 2024 (Figure 3).

Figure 1 Monthly change in retail turnover
